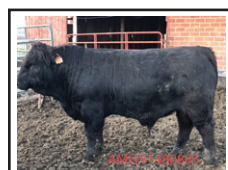

Well, it's 28 days to March 1st. Calves will be hitting the ground quickly. Most of the time I don't pay much attention to the USDA reports. This Friday's cattle inventory report is notable for the revisions that were made on last year's numbers. I think most of us felt that cattle numbers didn't reflect the terrible winters from flooding from 2019. The 2020 calf crop was revised down quite a bit reflecting also a smaller cow herd. I'm not saying there is anything diabolical going on at USDA but it sure reassures me why I don't pay much attention to the numbers. What's that saying? Figures lie & Liars figure! I'm guessing with higher grain prices over all beef production should drop significantly. Choice beef cutouts closed near their highest levels ever. Cutouts support Fed cattle near \$1.45 live. I hope the packers can survive on the near \$500/hd of margin they are operating on. We need M-COOL back!!

Our numbers Tuesday, were drastically lower due to Monday's significant snow. Not enough Fed cattle for a trend. Weigh cows were quite a bit stronger.

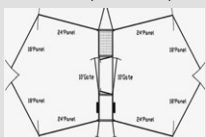
